In tandem chemical action and COMMON SIDE EFFECTS OF HEART AND/OR BLOOD PRESSURE DRUGS USED unnecessary BECAUSE: The real cause of increased: pulse rate, blood pressure and/or hypertension and/or lung inflammation ARE NOT treated; instead these symptoms are treated with unnecessary heart and/or blood pressure drugs.

NOTE: that many of the drugs have the same side effects and when used together will in tandem compound the same side effects!

Following information extracted from US-GOV MEDLINE PLUS Documented information for each drug

Be careful not to get **albuterol** inhalation into your eyes. Before using albuterol inhalation, tell your doctor if you have or have ever had an irregular heartbeat, heart disease, high blood pressure.

Albuterol may cause side effects. Tell your doctor if any of these symptoms are severe or do not go away:

- uncontrollable shaking of a part of the body
- nervousness
- headache
- nausea
- vomiting
- cough
- throat irritation
- muscle, bone, or back pain

Some side effects can be serious. If you experience any of the following symptoms, call your doctor immediately:

- fast, pounding, or irregular heartbeat
- chest pain
- rash
- hives
- itching
- swelling of the face, throat, tongue, lips, eyes, hands, feet, ankles, or lower legs
- increased difficulty breathing
- difficulty swallowing
- hoarseness

Be careful not to get **levalbuterol** inhalation into your eyes. Before using levalbuterol (Xopenex) tell your doctor if you have or have ever had high blood pressure, irregular heartbeat.

Levalbuterol may cause side effects:

- headache
- dizziness
- nervousness
- uncontrollable shaking of a part of the body
- heartburn
- vomiting
- cough
- weakness
- fever
- diarrhea
- muscle pain
- leg cramps

Some side effects can be serious:

- fast or pounding heartbeat
- chest pain
- hives
- skin rash
- itchina
- swelling of the face, throat, tongue, lips, eyes, hands, feet, ankles, or lower legs
- increased difficulty breathing or difficulty swallowing
- hoarseness

Amlodipine **aka Norvasc** may cause side effects.

- swelling of the hands, feet, ankles, or lower legs
- headache
- upset stomach
- stomach pain
- dizziness or lightheadedness
- drowsiness
- excessive tiredness
- flushing (feeling of warmth)

Lisinopril may cause side effects:

- cough
- dizziness
- headache
- excessive tiredness
- upset stomach
- diarrhea
- weakness

Some Amlodipine side effects can be serious.

- more frequent or more severe chest pain
- rapid, pounding, or irregular heartbeat
- fainting

Some **Lisinopril** side effects can be serious:

- swelling of the face, throat, tongue, lips, eyes, hands, feet, ankles, or lower legs
- hoarseness
- difficulty breathing or swallowing
- fever, sore throat, chills, and other signs of infection
- lightheadedness
- fainting

Before taking prednisone, tell your doctor what prescriptions you are taking and be sure to mention any of the following: **diltiazem** (Cardizem), aspirin, and/or if you have or have ever had: high blood pressure; emotional problems; or osteoporosis which are only a few of the drugs and/or conditions listed.

You should also know that **prednisone** may decrease your ability to fight infection and may prevent you from developing symptoms if you get an infection.

Prednisone may cause side effects:

- headache
- dizziness
- difficulty falling asleep or staying asleep
- inappropriate happiness
- · extreme changes in mood
- changes in personality
- bulging eyes
- acne
- thin, fragile skin
- red or purple blotches or lines under the skin
- slowed healing of cuts and bruises
- increased hair growth
- changes in the way fat is spread around the body
- extreme tiredness
- weak muscles
- irregular or absent menstrual periods
- decreased sexual desire
- heartburn
- increased sweating

Some Prednisone side effects can be serious:

- swelling of the eyes, face, lips, tongue, throat, arms, hands, feet, ankles, or lower legs
- difficulty breathing or swallowing
- vision problems
- eye pain, redness, or tearing
- sore throat, fever, chills, cough, or other signs of infection
- seizures
- depression
- sudden weight gain
- loss of contact with reality

Before taking diltiazem, tell your doctor what prescriptions you are taking.

Many other medications may also interact with **diltiazem**, so be sure to tell your doctor about all the medications you are taking, even those that do not appear on this list.

NOTE: **Prednisone** was not on listed in **diltiazem** warning, but the **Prednisone** information warned about using **Prednisone** with **Diltiazem**.

Diltiazem may cause side effects. Tell your doctor if any of these symptoms are severe or do not go away:

- dizziness or lightheadedness
- flushing (feeling of warmth)
- headache
- weakness
- slow heartbeat
- vomiting
- diarrhea
- constipation
- nasal congestion
- cough

Some **diltiazem** side effects can be serious.

- swelling of the face, eyes, lips, tongue, hands, arms, feet, ankles, or lower legs
- difficulty breathing or swallowing
- fainting
- rash
- yellowing of the skin or eyes
- nausea
- extreme tiredness
- unusual bleeding or bruising
- lack of energy

- confusion
- muscle twitching or tightening
- shaking of the hands that you cannot control
- numbness, burning, or tingling in the face, arms, legs, feet, or hands
- upset stomach
- vomiting
- lightheadedness
- irregular heartbeat
- shortness of breath, especially during the night
- dry, hacking cough
- swelling or pain in the stomach

- loss of appetite
- pain in the upper right part of the stomach
- flu-like symptoms
- increase in frequency or severity of chest pain (angina) **Symptoms of overdose may include:**
- slow, fast, or irregular heartbeat
- fainting
- difficulty breathing
- seizures
- dizziness
- confusion
- nausea
- vomiting
- increased sweating
